

SNIA 2013 Storage Developer Conference SNIA iSCSI Plugfest Application and Agreement

Participation in the SNIA iSCSI Plugfest costs \$495 per participant, which allows the participant to participate in the iSCSI Plugfest and attend the full SDC Conference.

The SNIA will provide and support the networks and infrastructure for the iSCSI Plugfest, creating a collaborative framework for testing. A platform test bench consists of a six foot table work area, a standard I I0 volt I5-amp power drop and network connection. Each participating company will be provided with one test bench for each platform they plan to test. For special power requirements please contact the SNIA for additional costs.

Plugfest testing starts on Sunday Sept. 15th at 8:30am, with time available for setup on Saturday Sept. 14th starting at 1:00pm. The Plugfest will conclude and teardown will begin starting at 1:00pm on Thursday Sept. 19th, with everything removed from the room by 5:00pm.

All companies participating in the iSCSI Plugfest are required to submit a completed and signed iSCSI Plugfest Application (this document) and a Plugfest Confidentiality Agreement.
