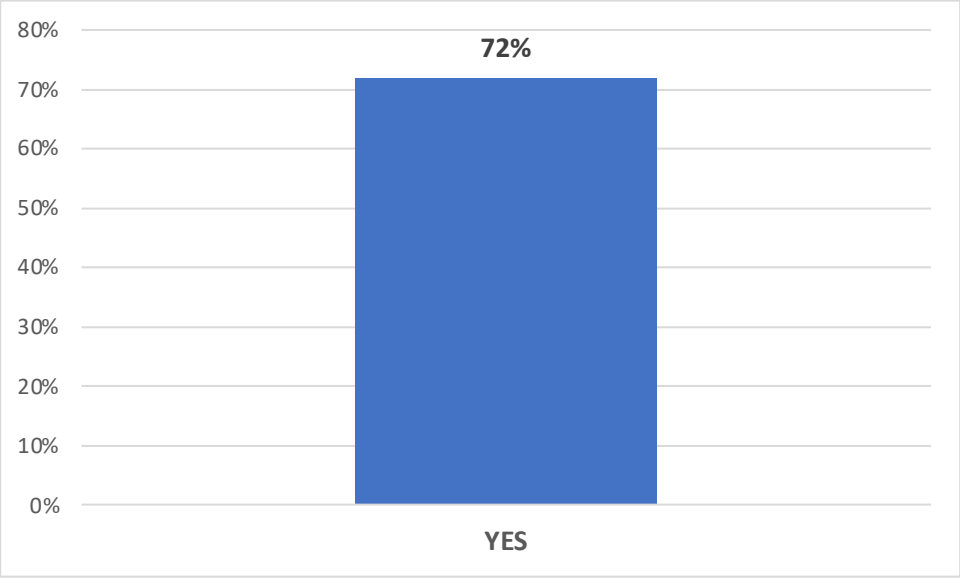
CSTI 2024 Focus

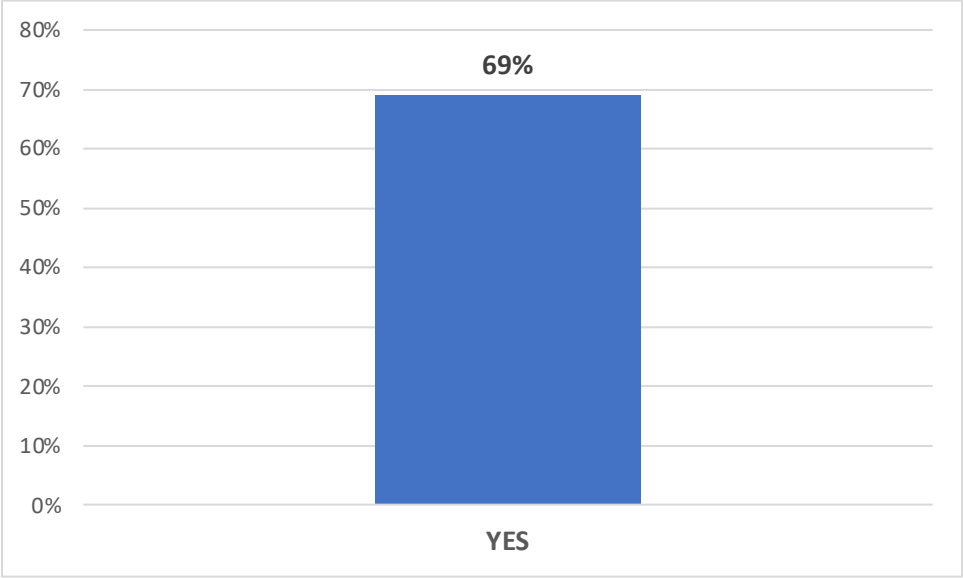


Cloud Object Storage Poll Results
