The purpose of this Plugfest is for vendors to bring their implementations of iSCSI to test, identify, and fix bugs in a collaborative setting with the goal of providing a forum in which companies can develop interoperable products.

The SNIA provides and supports networks and infrastructure for the iSCSI Plugfest, creating a collaborative framework for testing. The participants of the iSCSI Plugfest work together to define the testing process, assuring that objectives are accomplished.

The SNIA iSCSI Plugfest offers:

- Technical support from iSCSI engineers to look at traces and help with diagnosing problems
- Plugfest participants are covered by a non-disclosure agreement and entry is restricted to registrants only
- We will open the iSCSI Plugfest to all SDC attendees for a reception on Monday evening, as an open house for an insider's view
