



SNIA Member Categories

Vendors

A Vendor member is an organization that develops Information Technology (IT) products, optionally coupled with professional consulting, integration, and implementation services. Vendors may deliver their offering(s) under their brand, or may OEM them for other vendors or channel enterprises.

Service Providers

A Service Provider member is an organization that provides managed IT and or communication services to other businesses typically on a periodic subscription business model. This includes infrastructure as a service, storage and data management as a service, platform as a service, network as a service, data insurance as a service and software as a service.

Channel

A Channel member is an organization that offers solutions and professional services for vendors' and reseller (VAR), reseller, system integrator or consultantcy.

End Users

An End User member is an organization that is the ultimate final consumer of a product or service, and is typically represented by the IT department of an organization. End users may join as dues- paying corporate or individual members.

Technology Affiliate Member

A Technology Affiliate Member is a restricted voting membership specific to a technology domain focused on technical specifications and interoperability. A TA member does not need to be a full member of SNIA.

Vendor Startup

A Vendor Startup is an organization with revenue less than \$10M/year and in business less than 4 years

SNIA grants complimentary access to Non-Profit/Educational Institutions that comply with the SNIA Membership Agreement. A Non-Profit Institution is defined as an accredited non-profit institution and an Educational Institution is defined as any accredited higher learning institution. Qualified candidates from Educational Institutions include professors and/or students engaged in research/learning around storage.
